

Our guide to understanding the 2010 Federal tax credit

General info for homeowner tax credits

All pre-painted steel (bare steel is not eligible for the credit) offered in Steelogic SColor are Energy Star-rated, and qualify homeowners for a 30% tax credit, up to \$1,500 of the material cost. (Available for existing homes only. Installation and labor costs not eligible for the tax credit.)

- Qualifying energy-efficient (Energy Star-rated and painted) steel roofing must be placed in service (installed), beginning January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010. Any energy-efficient steel roofing installed prior to January 1, 2009 is not eligible for the Federal Tax Credit. The total \$1,500 tax credit is available over the January 1, 2009- December 31, 2010 time period, meaning homeowners can apply for a total of \$1,500 over the two year period. (Example: A homeowner claiming \$500 worth of the credit in 2009, can only claim up to \$1,000 in material costs in 2010).
- The Federal Tax incentive is a Credit, not a deduction, meaning homeowners receive up to \$1,500 straight into their wallet, not indirectly as many deductions offer.

- 2. Download and print a copy of the manufacturer's certification on our website.**
